- 1- LENT is coming! In this Simply Blessed you will read about the two different opportunities for worship. However, we are also participating in the Dutch Fork Cluster Lent worship services with our Lutheran neighbors. I really hope you will consider attending these services as representatives of Bethel. A group of pastors and musicians have worked hard together to prepare these services and create space for deepening discipleship and faith community. We have not been able to gather with these neighboring churches since before COVID (in 2020) and this is certainly a joyful opportunity to embrace reconnecting with our neighbors in faith.


